The Bad News Ephesians 2:1-3 | Jason Krute, Senior Pastor

The Old Creation

- ...you were dead in the trespasses and sins...
 - our former state was spiritual death; separation from God
 - Isaiah 59:1-2; Romans 6:23; Ephesians 4:17-19; Colossians 2:13-14; Titus 3:3-7
- ...once walked, following the course of this world...
 - they (Ephesian Christians) used to (past tense) have a different attitude and priority in life
 - Jeremiah 7:23-24: 1 Corinthians 3:18-21a: Colossians 1:21: 1 Peter 4:1-3
- ...the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience...
 - -contrast to the Spirit that has sealed them
 - -1 Corinthians 2:11-13; 2 Corinthians 4:4; Ephesians 6:12; 1 John 5:19
- ...we all once lived in the passions of our flesh...
 - we all had chased selfish motives at one point; we all needed to be ransomed out (redeemed)
 - Satan deceives people to think their good behavior is enough to be good with God (Paul recognizes this deception from his life in Philippians 3)
- ...carrying out the desires of the body and the mind...
 - to reuse the phrase from Judges, we all have had the attitude of "everyone did what was right in their own eyes"
 - Judges 17:6; 21:25; Deuteronomy 12:8



Solomon and Ruby Kendagor are based in St. Louis but have a truly global ministry.

From their basement broadcasting studio, they reach over 5 million people across 58 countries through television, radio, and Facebook Bible studies. They are also actively involved in mentoring and supporting international students in their local community.

In addition to their local work, the Kendagors frequently travel to Africa to train and equip pastors and other Christian leaders. This summer, they will travel to Togo and Benin to lead a five-day conference with attendees from 14 West African countries, including pastors and government leaders. A key focus will be the impact of voodoo and witchcraft, which remain major challenges for the Christian church in the region.

As you pray for the Kendagors, praise God for their ongoing work both here and in Africa. Pray for this upcoming conference, that God's word would prevail over the false teaching and spiritual strongholds in Africa.
