Kelly* is our healthcare worker in the Middle East. She and her staff run a health clinic for refugees, which they use as a conduit to the Gospel. Kelly serves in an area where refugees are seen as outcasts and don't have access to adequate resources. Many of them live in tents on farmers' land and are at the mercy of the farmers as to how long they can stay. Recent bombings in the area have led to massive shortages of food and basic supplies.

In addition to healthcare services, the clinic provides many other services to the refugee population, such as a construction course for boys and a nursing course for girls, where they can learn valuable skills to support themselves in the future. They also meet many practical, physical needs of the refugees.

The January Change for Change offering will go to Kelly and her clinic so they can continue to provide services to the refugees at a time where there is much uncertainty in the area. If you'd like to give, drop your donation in one of the offering boxes in the building, or give online.
