Some key takeaways:

- 1. As the impatience of Saul and the army escalates, a foolish decision is made out of fear. How does fear play a role in your decision-making? Positive spin: How does faith in God's timing play a role in your decision-making?
- 2. Saul offers sacrifices when it is not his role. He also never apologizes for his folly. Are there people to whom you have never apologized for your own folly/ sin?
- 3. The kingship will not stay with Saul. Samuel is already planting the seed of a better King. Have you found that better King in your life? Have you told others about Jesus' great love?
